



## **Bunny Tyler Memorial Scholarship for Women in Business Sponsored by Zonta Club of the Black Hills**

The Zonta Club of the Black Hills established the Bunny Tyler Memorial Scholarship for Women in Business in 2010 in remembrance of local business woman and volunteer Dorothy "Bunny" Tyler. Bunny and her husband owned and operated National Van Lines and Black Hills Mayflower Moving and Storage. Bunny was also very active in many Rapid City organizations, including: Zonta Club of the Black Hills, SCORE, Toastmasters, and Business & Professional Women. Bunny epitomized the ideals of Zonta, which include advancing the Status of Women worldwide. She actively advocated for advancing the status of women and was elected Governor of District 12 of Zonta International. A strong and successful business woman, dedicated and compassionate volunteer, and proud, loving mother and grandmother, Bunny's legacy lives on in this scholarship, funded by her family, friends and sister Zontians.

### **The Scholarship**

The Bunny Tyler Memorial Scholarship for Women in Business is awarded to women undertaking business studies who have demonstrated outstanding potential in the business field and have dedicated time and service to their community. The amount awarded is \$250.00.

### **What are the Requirements?**

- Women enrolled in a 2 or 4-year university/college accredited business undergraduate or MBA program
- Demonstrated leadership through volunteer/community service
- Resident of South Dakota
- Non-Traditional Student (24 years or older)
- Recipient needs to provide proof of enrollment upon being notified as a scholarship recipient
